#### What God Wants Us To Do With Our Guilt

1. \_\_\_\_\_\_it.

The Lord gave us a mind and a conscience. We cannot hide from ourselves. (Proverbs 20:27)

If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)

### <u>Life Lesson</u> To stop *defeating* myself, I must stop *deceiving* myself.

2. \_\_\_\_\_ responsibility.

"I recognize my faults; I am aware of my sins..." (Psalm 51:3)

<u>Life Lesson</u> You will never learn from something you refuse to see. If we freely admit that we have sinned, we find God utterly reliable ... He forgives your sins and makes you thoroughly clean from all that is evil. (1 John 1:9)

All of us have sinned, yet God declares us "not guilty" if we trust in Jesus Christ, who in His mercy freely takes away our sin. (Romans 3:23-24)

#### Life Lesson

### It doesn't matter what you've done. What matters is what Jesus has done for you.

### What God Does With My Guilt

#### 1. He forgives \_\_\_\_\_

God is merciful and quick to forgive. (Isaiah 55:7)

#### 2. He forgives \_\_\_\_\_

He has forgiven <u>ALL</u> your sins. He has <u>utterly wiped out</u> the evidence of broken commandments which always hung over our heads, and has <u>completely annulled</u> it by nailing it to the cross! (Colossians 2:13-14)

### 3. He forgives \_\_\_\_\_\_.

Jesus is always interceding on our behalf. (Hebrews 7:25)

## 4. He forgives \_\_\_\_\_\_.

For by the sacrificial death of Christ, we are <u>set free</u> – that is, our sins are forgiven. How great is the grace of God! (Ephesians 1:7)

What <u>happiness</u> for those whose guilt has been forgiven! .... What <u>relief</u> for those who God has cleared their record! (Psalm 32:1-2)
