Lesson 1

So often we limit our thinking. We think we'll never turn things around. We'll never overcome our problems. We don't have the connections, the talent, or the money. But we tend to look for answers only in the *natural* world. We forget that God is a *supernatural* God. And just because we don't see a way doesn't mean that God doesn't have a way.

Lesson 2

You don't have to figure it all out. _____

Remember Abraham and Sarah? God promised Sarah a child. At first, she didn't believe it. She thought she was too old. But God said in Genesis 18:14 – "Is there anything too hard for the Lord?" The Amplified Bible puts it this way: "Is there anything too hard or too wonderful for the Lord?" He's saying, "If you'll take the limits off Me, I'll amaze you with My goodness."

"Who would have thought" blessings ... That's just what happened to Sarah in the Bible. She had a baby, even though she was well beyond childbearing years. It was an over-the-top blessing, and she knew it. She said, "Who would have thought I could have a child at such an old age?" (Genesis 21:7)

Lesson 3

God wants to _____ with His goodness.

"Lean not on your own understanding." (Proverbs 3:5)

Sometimes there is no logical solution. Sometimes there is no natural way out. If you constantly try to figure it out, you'll just get frustrated. Eventually, you'll get discouraged and give up. But understand this: Just because you can't see a way doesn't mean that God doesn't have a way.
