What Matters to God When You Pray?

1. Your _____ matter.

“And when you are praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins.” (Mark 11:25)

“Husbands, be considerate as you live with your wives and treat them with respect ... so that nothing will hinder your prayers.” (1 Peter 1:3)

2. Your _____ matter.

“When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives.” (James 4:3)

“All a person’s ways seem pure to them, but motives are weighed by the Lord.” (Proverbs 16:2)

3. Your _____ matters.

“But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.” (James 1:6-7)

“Jesus touched their eyes and said, ‘According to your faith let it be done to you,’ and their sight was restored.” (Matthew 9:29-30)

4. God’s _____ matters.
