## Introduction

Trouble at 36,000 feet over the Atlantic!

Now read the actual story in Mark 4: 35-41.

I am confident. I am secure. I can rise above this. 1. You can be in the storm, but ... \_\_\_\_\_

The Bible tells of a time when Jesus was in a small boat when suddenly a fierce storm came up. (Mark 4:35-41) The boat was battered by the wind and the waves, but Jesus remained cool, calm, and in control. The reason Jesus was able to bring calm to that situation was because He had peace inside Himself. He was in the storm, but He didn't let the storm get in Him. You can be in the storm, but don't let the storm get in you.

#### Use your faith to \_\_\_\_\_\_

Be like the Apostle Paul. Paul experienced all kinds of heartache, conflict, and difficulties. But he said, "In spite of all this, we are more than conquerors." (Romans 8:37) That's the kind of attitude that we need to have. Don't use your faith to get rid of your problems. Use your faith to remain calm in the midst of your problems.

#### 3. To get rid of your pest, \_\_\_\_\_

Like an eagle, rise above it. Don't sink down to your opposition's level. Don't argue; don't try to pay somebody back; don't give them the cold shoulder. Be the bigger person. Remain calm and confident. Have a gentle spirit. (See Isaiah 40:29-31)
