Three Principles of Purpose

Definition: Purpose is the original intent that the designer had in mind when he designed something. The purest definition of sin comes from the Biblical Greek word *hamartia*, an archery term which means, "To miss the mark, to miss the target." To miss your purpose – that's what sin is.
