Part 5: Step into the Unknown

God has a "route overview" for your life. Before you were formed in your mother's womb, He laid out the plan. He not only knows your final destination, He knows the best way to get you there.

But, unlike the navigation system on your car, God doesn't show you the "route overview." He doesn't tell you how it's going to happen, how long it's going to take, where the funds are coming from, or who you're going to meet.

The Problem: We want

"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." (Psalm 119:105)

A "lamp" implies you have enough light to see right in front of you. God is not giving you a light that shows your life for the next fifty years.

It's like the headlights of your car. When you're driving at night, you can only see a hundred feet or so. But you don't stop driving because you can't see your destination, which is 25 miles ahead. You just keep going, seeing as much as the lights allow, knowing you'll eventually arrive at your destination.
