Lesson 1: You are _____ than what you're missing.

Do you really think God would just drop you into your life and not put inside you the things you would need for what He has called you to do?

When you don't feel like you're enough, tell yourself, "I am enough because God knew I would be here. He knew what I'd need for this situation. If He put me in this situation, He put His strength in me."

I'll say it again: You are enough. You have nothing to prove, no one to impress, nobody to fear. You are handmade by God. He calls you by name. He knows the hairs on your head and the thoughts in your heart. He values you, loves you, fills you, empowers you.

Don't be like the 9-year-old I heard about who was tricked out of his Michael Jordan collector's card.

Lesson 2: _____ **are for kids.**

You can't just accept Jesus by faith. You have to accept yourself by faith.

Sure, you're a work in progress. But you are beautiful, valuable, and important right now too.

David wrote: "I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I know full well ... How precious to me are Your thoughts, God! How vast the sum of them!"
(Psalm 139:14, 17)

Jesus is knocking right now!

Maybe you're thinking, "Jeff, I wish I could have your confidence. Your optimism. Your way of seeing things."

You can! My confidence, my optimism, my positive self-image – all of that comes from having Christ in me. And you can have that, too.
