# Part 6: God is Able

“Everybody has a disability ... some are just more visible than others.”

Take your eyes off your disability ... and put them on God's ability!

“Go in the strength you have.” (Judges 6:14)

If you take the word **disable** and put “Go” in front of it, it spells
